Pat was born January 25, 1959 in Cortland, New York, to David F. and Marie (Gorman) Prindle. She is survived by her sisters, Jane (Richard) Kilgore, Anne (Donn) Chamberlain, Christine (Rich) Hawthorne and Mary (Dennis Nourse) Prindle; brothers, Fred (Kelly) Prindle, David (Sharon) Prindle and Daniel Prindle; many nieces and nephews; and her pets, Sheba, Lonesome and Duncan. Pete was a graduate of Fabius-Pompey Central High School and attended SUNY Morrisville. She was employed at Astride Inc. for six years, self employed as a housekeeper for 25 years and as a stable manager for 30 years.

She was an avid equestrian and was involved in many horse organizations; St. Jude Ride (Poker Ride Coordinator for six years), Astride Inc. for six years, Central New York Horse Club, Turn Tree Trail Riders, 4H Club Leader for 10 years, Cherry Valley Riders, participated in Chief Joseph Ride in Idaho, Montana and Washington for five years, Walking Horse Club, Morrisville, American Quarter Horse Assoc., Appaloosa Horse Club and America Paint Association. 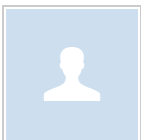

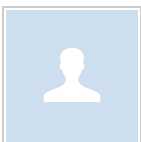

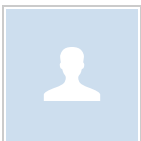
