Paul R. King, 89, died Tuesday, June 16, 2009 at his home in Tully Valley, New York. He was the son of the late LeRoy and Myra (Riehlman) King. He and his brother Gerald were the 4th generation owners and operators of the family farm, King's Royal Acres, until he retired in 1987. He was a life member of Cardiff Methodist Church, past Treasurer of Cardiff Cemetery Association, member of the Tully Valley Grange #646 and served on the Grievance Board of the Town of Lafayette. He hosted the 1970 Empire Farm Days. Paul loved music and played the organ and vibraphone professionally.

Paul is survived by his wife of 66 years, Winifred Keehfus King; four daughters. Linda (Larry) Raison of LaFayette, New York, Sandra (Gary) Booher of Tully, New York, Colleen (Peter) Carlton of Otisco, New York and Paula (Bob) Thompson of LaFayette, New York; seven grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.
