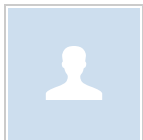

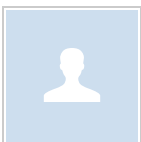
“ Boss,sorry to hear about Penny.We missed you guys the last few years.If you are around the pond look me up.
