Phyllis Ann Moore Moran, 77, of The Valley in Syracuse, New York, died Saturday, January 28, 2006 at home.

Phyllis was born January 5, 1929 in Syracuse, New York, the daughter of John Alexander and Pauline Johanna (Hosp) Moore. She was a life resident of Syracuse, a 1946 graduate of Assumption Catholic Academy and The Syracuse Comptomer School.
