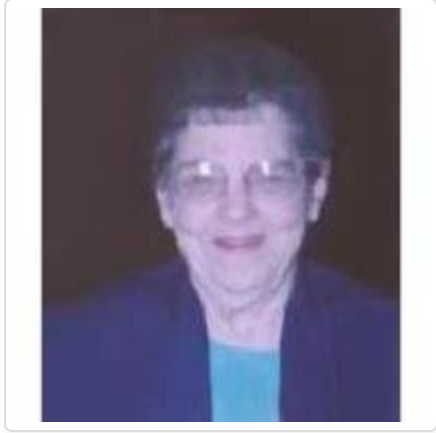




Priscilla Mae Sleeth

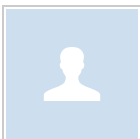
