Raymond E. Deuel, Jr., age 84, of Syracuse, New York died Tuesday, March 12, 2002 at Loretto, Syracuse.

Mr. Deuel was born October 26, 1917 in Cortland, New York, the son of Raymond and Ruth (McQuen) Deuel. Formerly of Valley Vista Apts., Syracuse, he lived in Port Richey, Florida and Rochester, New York before moving back to Syracuse in 1993. He was a 1938 graduate of Onondaga Valley Academy. He retired in 1978 after more than 40 years in the grocery business. He worked at Loblaws, Terrell and Cavanaugh before founding Deuel Distributing Co.
