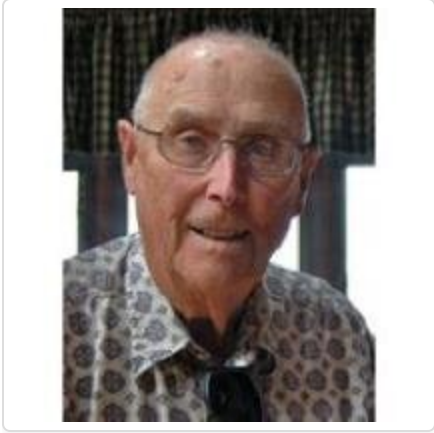




Robert H Booher

April 30, 1924 - March 3, 2011

Robert H. Booher, 86, passed away Thursday, March 3, 2011 in Florida Citrus County. Born in Syracuse, New York, Bob was the son of the late Hayes McKinley and Edna (Brooks) Booher. He was a graduate of Onondaga Valley Academy and attended Hamilton College prior to his service in the Navy during World War II as a torpedo bomber pilot. He was the former owner of Booher Lumber Co. and retired as President of B&B Lumber Co. He was a founding member of LaFayette Alliance Church and attended River Community Church in Clayton, New York and Seven Rivers Presbyterian Church in Lecanto, Florida. He served on the Board of The Rescue Mission. Bob is survived by his beloved wife of 64 years, Dorothea (White) Booher of Williamstown, New York; two sons, Gary Robert (Sandra) Booher of Jamesville, New York and Jeffrey Hayes (Dorothy) Booher of Chittenango, New York; one daughter, Martha (Tom) Smith of Clayton, New York; 12 grandchildren and 30 great-grandchildren. 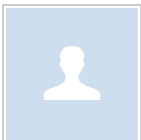

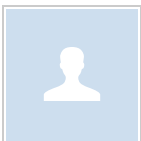

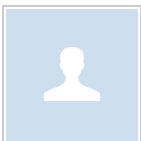
