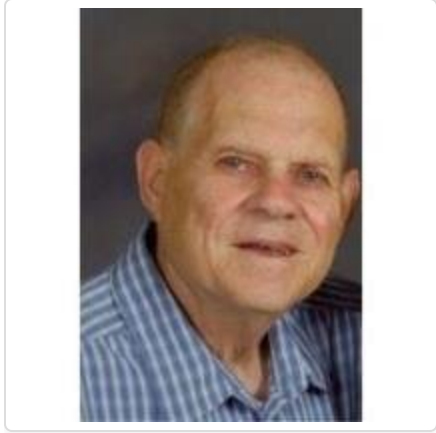




Robert D. DeOrdio

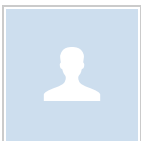
