Sigmund John "Siggy" Brzostowski, 57 of Lafayette, New York died Saturday, December 4, 2004 at University Hospital, Syracuse.

Shigmund was born January 30, 1947 in Syracuse, New York, the son of Sigmund and Ivy Belle (VanDyke) Brzostowski. He was a communicant of St. Joseph's Church, Lafayette, New York. Siggy retired from New Process Gear in 2004 as a fork lift operator following 33 years of service. He was a U.S. Army veteran serving two tours of duty in Vietnam. He was a green beret serving with the special forces. He was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing. He was pre-deceased by a sister, Rebecca Brzostowski, in 1965.
