Stephen John Carbacio, age 79, of Dewitt, New York died Monday, July 1, 2002 at Crouse Hospital, Syracuse, New York.

Mr. Carbacio was born July 14, 1922 in Syracuse, New York, the son of Vito and Angelina (Fedele) Corbacio. He was a graduate of North High School and attended Massachusetts Institute of Technology where he received an Associates Degree in Diesel Engineering.
