Timothy D. Cook, age 51 of Lafayette, New York died Monday, April 25, 2005 at home.

Timothy was born July 9, 1953 in Syracuse, New York, the son of Donald H. and June M. (Mumford) Cook. He was a graduate of Wayne Central High School in Ontario, New York and Onondaga Community College in Syracuse, New York. He was a self-employed electronic repairman operating Sound Solutions in Lafayette. Tim was a professional bass guitarist and vocalist performing with numerous area bands including B B Bop, The Steve Rice Band and Black-N-Blue. He was a very active volunteer with Camp Good Days performing for numerous benefits.
