Former Syracuse resident Timothy Robert Galvin, 56, of Kissimmee, Florida passed away on Thursday, November 4, 2010 after a courageous battle with cancer. Tim was born in Syracuse, New York, the son of Maurice Robert and Louise Galvin. Tim worked most of his life with the Carrier Corporation serving in many capacities. Tim married Elaine Wycherley Galvin on February 25, 1978. They spent most of their lives living in Cicero, New York with their three children before moving to Florida in 2004. Tim's life was devoted to his wife, children and grandchildren. He was a mentor to countless youths serving as a baseball and softball coach in the Cicero Little League for many years. Tim was preceded in death by his son, Michael and his father, Maurice Robert Galvin.
