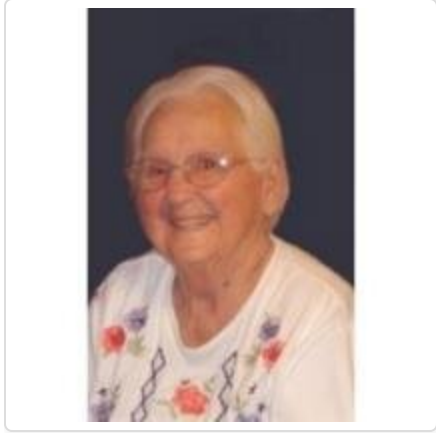




Veronica R. Barcza
