Walter F. Mamed, 89, of Chaffee Avenue in Syracuse, New York, died Saturday, March 31, 2007 at home.

Walter was born November 20, 1917 in Brazil, the son of Julio and Angelica (Falcao) Mamede. At 17, he joined the Brazilian Army where he served for 10 years. He was employed by Carrier Corp. in Rio, Brazil and when he came to Syracuse in 1948, he continued to work for Carrier Corp. He retired from Pass & Seymour Inc., in Solvay, New York in 1982 after 20 years. He served in the US Coast Guard Auxiliary and the Syracuse Sail & Power Squadron, both for over 25 years. He was a member of HAM operators and a communicant of Our Lady of Lourdes Church. He loved his grandchildren and enjoyed family get-togethers.

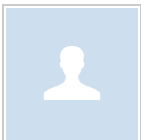
