William (Bill) A. Osadchey 70 of LaFayette, passed away Saturday July 15 at St. Joseph's Hospital, Syracuse. Bill retired as a Lt.Colonel in the United States Air Force after serving for 22 years. Following his retirement from the Air Force he was employed by Onondaga County as a case worker in Child Protective Services. Bill received his BA/Education from SUNY Cortland in 1968, MA/Business Administration from Troy State University in 1978 and another MS/International Logistics Management from the Armed Forces Institute of Technology in 1979. He was a dedicated public servant throughout his life.

Bill is survived by his loving wife, the former Linda Case, two sons Brian William Osadchey of LaFayette and Todd James Osadchey of Cocoa Beach, FL. A grandson Derek James Osadchey of McKinney TX. He was predeceased by his mother, Barbara Stisser Osadchey, and his father, Alex Carlton Osadchey of Truxton.
