Winifred "Winnie" Brock Leonard, 88, of Constantia, New York died Tuesday, February 14, 2006 at Iroquois Nursing Home in Jamesville, New York.

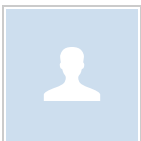

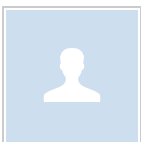

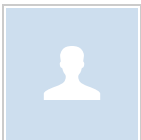
